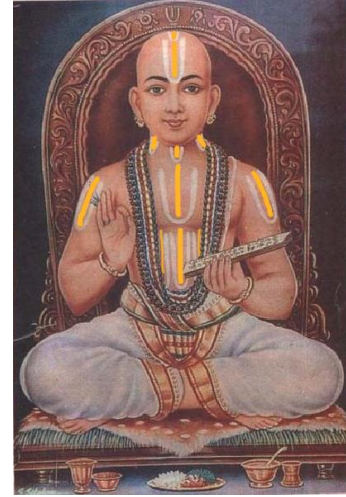

## Significance of Purattasi Sravanam:

Sravana: Nakshatra is the Thiru Nakshatra of Sriman Narayana. Sravana Nakshatra of Purattasi month has special significance being the "avathara dhinam (jayanthi)" of none other than the Lord of Seven Hills, Sri Venkateshwara. This day is celebrated with the culmination of "Chakara Snanam (Theerthavaari)", the highlight of Brahmotsavam at Thirumala for Srivaari, Malaiyappa Swami. A special Abhishekam will be followed by Unjal Sevai for the Utsava Moorthy at our temple to celebrate this occasion.

## Om Sri Venkateshaya Namah:

Purattasi Sravanam happens to be the avathara dhinam of Swami Vedanta Desika. Swami Desika is considered to be the avathara of the Ganda-Mani (Bell) at Thirupathi and gave us numerous granthas in Sanskrit and Tamil including Dhaya Sathakam (on the Kaarunya of Lord Srinivasa), Paduka Sahasram (on Lord Sri Ranganatha), Sri Sthuthi, Godha Sthuthi and the list goes on and on. Swami Deiska is a versatile genius who permanently set Ramanuja's philosophy on firm footing.
